1 gram - Size 11 Semi-Glazed Opaque Orange Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho - 2611F (SB7193) 1 gram - Size 11 Duracoat Opaque Dyed Cheddar Orange Round Japanese Seed Beads by Miyuki – 4454 (SB7438)

1 gram - Size 11 Semi-Glazed Opaque Turquoise Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho - 2604F(SB7186) 1 gram - Size 11 Silver Plated Metal Round Seed Bead (SB1944)

2 - 4mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2747)

18 - 22 gauge Silver Plated Base Metal 2 inch Head Pin with 2mm Ball (BM2508)

2 - 22 gauge Silver Plated Brass 2 inch Eye Pin (BM2663)

1 - Brass Ball Post Earring with Closed Ring - Silver - 6mm (BM2880)

- 1 Base Metal Clutch Earring Back Silver 5mm (BM2872)
- 2 Base Metal 2mm Flat Oval Link Cable Chain Silver (CN3200)

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Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Simple Loop Cutting Chain Efficiently

Instructions to complete "Fiesta Fringe" earrings:

NOTE: the images are showing the beads in a different colorway.

Step 1

String the following beads onto one head pin:

- 7 turquoise seed beads
- 1 silver seed bead
- 3 orange seed beads
- 1 silver seed bead
- 5 cheddar orange seed beads




Step 2

Using round nose pliers, turn a loop at the end of the head pin (see Simple Loop Technique).



Step 3 Repeat Steps 1 – 2 8 times, making a total of 9 bead units.



Step 4


Using wire cutters, cut the cable chain into the following lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique): 2 - 2-link lengths 2 - 4-link lengths

- 2 6-link lengths
- 2 8-link lengths
- 1 10-link length
- 1 21-link length



Line your chain lengths up in the following sequence for one earring:

- 1 2-link lengths
- 1 4-link lengths
- 1 6-link lengths
- 1 8-link lengths
- 1 10-link length
- 1 8-link lengths
- 1 6-link lengths
- 1 4-link lengths
- 1 2-link lengths



Step 6

String the following onto 1 eye pin:

- 1 2-link lengths
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1-4-link lengths
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1 6-link lengths
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1 81-link lengths
- 1 10-link length
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1 8-link lengths
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1 6-link lengths
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1 4-link lengths
- 1 silver seed bead
- 1 2-link lengths




Using round nose pliers, turn a loop at the end of the eye pin (see Simple Loop Technique).



Step 8

Open the loop on one bead unit made in Step 1, and attach it to the end link of the 2-link chain length. Close the loop.



Step 9

Repeat step 8 for each of the chain lengths from step 6.



Open one end loop of the eye pin from Step 6, and attach one end of a 10-link length of chain. Close the loop.



Step 11

Open the second end loop of the eye pin from Step 6, and attach the other 10-link length of chain. Close the loop.



Step 12

Attach a jump ring through the ends of the chain lengths from steps 10-11.



Attach the loop of the earring post to the jump ring from step 12. Close the jump ring.



Step 14

Repeat Steps 1 – 13 for the second earring.
